A warm welcome to the transition unit!

Welcome back after the summer break. I hope you have all had an enjoyable summer. Please find enclosed information that will guide you and your child through the academic year. Wishing your child an enjoyable year in Unicorn class!

Teaching staff

Alongside myself will be Mrs Goodey (I am pleased to say that Mrs Riley got married over the summer). Mr Burke will also be supporting in class and covering my planning time on a Tuesday afternoon.

Personal belongings

Your child is responsible for looking after their own belongings. Please make it easier for them by naming all items of clothing, including coats, hats and scarves. Named PE kits should be left on their pegs and are sent home at the end of each half term.

Pencil cases can be brought into school, however these are not compulsory. Please ensure your child does not bring any toys into school. Your child may bring in their own book to read during our dedicated reading time.

PE/Forest school kit

As it is a requirement of the school curriculum, please ensure your child has a named PE kit in school at all times. Please see the website for details of the kit required. Indoor sessions will take place on Thursday and outdoor PE on Friday.

Forest School will be every other Wednesday afternoon, starting on September the 13th. Please ensure full kit is in school.

Jewellery is not to be worn for PE sessions and earrings will need to be removed on these days. Please note, PE days may change so ideally your child should be able to remove their own earrings.

Medical information

Please ensure that if your child needs any medication within school such as inhalers, that they are in date and the relevant medical form has been completed at the office. All medication should be clearly named and handed to the school office or myself as soon as possible. **Please note, it is the parents responsibility to ensure medication is in date.**

Reading

There is an expectation that children in Year 3 should be reading for a minimum of 10 minutes each night. This includes their school books and books from home/the library. All children will be given a reading diary and these should be signed whenever your child has read. Reading books and records should be brought to school each day. Your child will be given one book per week (depending on the length of the book) and this can be changed on a Tuesday. Your child should place their book in the labelled box when they have completed their book ready to be changed. Please ensure your child shows a good understanding of the text and can answer questions about what they have read.

Library

Our class library day is Friday where your child will have the opportunity to select a book from our fabulous school library. Please ensure books are returned on Friday ready to change. If your child would like to keep their book, they will still need to return in on Friday so it can be renewed.

Newsletters

In order to protect our planet, weekly school and class newsletters will be posted on our school website unless a paper copy is requested. Please let me know if you are unable to access the internet and require a paper copy.
