Easter Raffle - The PTA are holding an Eggciting Easter Raffle, where 3 Easter hampers are up for grabs. A strip of raffle tickets (5 individual tickets) are attached to this letter for you to buy or sell to your friends and family. **Each individual ticket costs £1.**

If you would like to purchase some or all the strips of tickets that you have received then please write the person's name and contact number clearly on the reverse of the tickets, and return them with the correct money, in the attached envelope, to your class teacher or school office by **Tuesday 28th March**. The winners will be announced on the Facebook page and at the school office, the hampers will be in the school reception for collection until Friday 31st March when school closes for the holidays.
