Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.45. The children are expected to come into school and organise their belongings and book bags independently. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this.

P.E

P.E will take place on Thursday and Friday afternoons. Children will need both an indoor and outdoor P.E. kit. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled.

Daily Snacks

Children are able to purchase toast from the school hall during morning playtime. The cost for this is 10p per day, however it is also possible to pay on a weekly basis if this is what you would prefer. Children may also bring in their own healthy snack to eat during morning break. Fruit will also be provided during milk and snack time.

Reading Books
