

English (Literacy)

We will start our half term with a book from a 'cold' place- Lost and Found and then a book from a 'hot' place- Handa's Hen and Handa's Surprise. We will also look at information books such as books about China and the Chinese New Year.

Phonics will be taught daily.

Guided Reading will take place weekly.

Children will learn new vocabulary through our jungle role play (linked to Handa's Surprise) and our Arctic role play (linked to Lost and Found)

Maths (Mathematics)

Children will continue to count objects to 20, ordering and then finding 1 more/1 less. Children will be encouraged to select the correct numerals to represent the numbers 1-10 and beyond. We will + and -.

We will develop our knowledge of shape and measuring (weight) and money.

We will begin to look at doubling and halving.

Art (Expressive art and design)

Textiles- creating jungle animals.

To use sculpture to create jungle animals.

Geography (Knowledge and Understanding of the World)

Children will be encouraged to talk about the features of their own immediate environment and how environments might vary from one another (link to Lost and Found and Handa)

Programming and Control- using Bee Bots around different places/maps. Using cameras to take photographs.

PE (Physical Development)- Children will learn Gymnastic skills

Science (Knowledge and Understanding of the World)

To encourage children to comment & ask questions about aspects of their familiar world e.g. the place where they live.
