STAFFING

We would like to remind parents that we have a clear policy in terms of dealing with any queries/concerns with reference to your child's learning. Please contact your child's class teacher, or, if you feel that this hasn't been dealt with sufficiently then you are welcome to arrange an appointment with Miss Fielding, who is the Assistant Head/Foundation Stage Leader.

MORNINGS

Parents are reminded that the classroom doors open at 8.45am every morning. At 8.55am all external classroom doors are then locked and any child arriving after this time will need to enter school via the main office.

We would like to remind parents that class teachers will be available at the doors, once they have been opened, should you need to talk to them.

UNIFORM

It is lovely to see the children in their new uniforms. So that the children don't lose or misplace any items of clothing we ask that you ensure that all items, including PE kits and wellies, are clearly labelled.

JEWELLERY

As in previous years, children are not to wear jewellery in school except stud earrings and watches. If a child is seen wearing jewellery, a member of staff will ask the child to remove this and will place this in a secure drawer/ locker for the child to take home at the end of the day. Girls are also reminded that they are not allowed to wear any nail varnish.

P.E.

P.E. will take place once a week (Thursday) for children in Year 1 (who will work with Turtles for PE on this afternoon) and begin in the Spring term for our Reception children. Please be aware that children cannot borrow kit. If, for whatever reason your child is unable to take part in PE we ask that you send in a parental note, otherwise there will be an expectation that your child participates in the PE session, using any spare kits that we might have in school.
