Counting

- Counting to 20 and beyond.
- Counting down from 20.

Number

- Recognising numbers 0-1-, 0-20 and beyond.
- Addition and Subtraction.
- One more/one less.
- Doubling.
- Halving.

Shape, Space and Measure

- Beginning to use mathematical names for 'solid' 3D shapes and 'flat' 2D shapes, and mathematical terms to describe shapes.
- Selects a particular named shape.
- Uses everyday language related to time.
- Orders and sequences familiar events.
- Measures short periods of time in simple ways.

Understanding the world:

- We will talk about spring and the changes in the environment.
- We will be exploring key events such as Mother's Day and Easter.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Weaving materials.
- Junk modelling.
- Make spring pictures.
- Make Mother's Day cards
- Creating paintings.
- Easter competition.
- Use musical instruments to retell stories- loud and quiet sounds to reflect the mood of the story.
