Let's go number crazy

Practise our adding and subtracting. Some of you will need to be practising this using mental strategies (counting on from a given number, counting back from a given number).

Number bonds to 10. (Yr1 – also number bonds to 20)

Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

Know one more and one less to at least 10.

Extension: 20.(Yr1- also find 10 less and 10 more than a given number)


Count to 20 and back again. (Yr1 count back from any given number)

Play hide the bear, where is it? In, under, on, next to, behind?

Sequence your day using time words- first, then, next, after that, finally. (yr1- try to include O'clock and half past times)

Find different 2D and 3D shapes in your kitchen.

Order items in your kitchen from heaviest to lightest (Yr1- look for the weight written on the packages)
