

English (Literacy)

This half term the children will read and look at variety of different traditional tales. They will look at the features of these stories, describe characters and make simple predications. They will also look at alternative versions of these traditional tales and look at the differences between them.

The children will continue to have their daily phonics sessions and guided reading sessions.

Mathematics

This half term the children will be able to focus on number and place value. We will also be focusing on addition and subtractions, 2D and 3D shapes and length, mass/weight. The children will be able to use a variety of maths resources to help them understand concepts.

Creative Curriculum

In our topic lessons the children will be learning about homes in the past and comparing them to homes in the present.

The children will also learn about old and new toys, old and new vehicles.

The children will look at the famous artist Andy Goldsworthy and his work. They will create their own pictures in this style using items from the forest

The children will also continue to go to forest school.

Computing -the children will be focusing on key skills using a computer

PE Children will practice travelling in a variety of ways; quick, slow, sideways and at a variety of speeds. They will practice climbing and jumping.

RE Children will discuss the groups they belong to. They will visit St Paul's church and learn about Baptism expression of belonging for Christians.

Science

In science the children will look at the unit: materials and their properties. They will look at different types of materials, both natural and man-made.

The children will look at their properties and uses and then carry out simple experiments for finding the best material (once given a criteria)

The children will make simple predictions, carry out experiments and then record their results.
