

Numeracy

In numeracy this half term the children will be looking at length mass and weight, addition and subtraction, fractions, position and direction and time. They will be able to use Numicon and base ten to support their learning as well as other resources.

Literacy

This half term the children will be studying the units: Recounts and Traditional Poems.

The children will be reading and looking at the story 'Supertato' and 'Nat Fantastic'. They will be able to focus on the structure of story looking at beginning middle and end. They will be able to write simple recounts of the stories using time connectives. They will also be able to look at character descriptions and alternative endings.

The children will also be able to look at traditional poems. They will look at the structure of poems and look at rhyming words and alliteration.

In addition to these units, the children will have their daily session of phonics and guided reading.

They will also have opportunity to practise handwriting.
