

### Literacy

Phonics will continue to take place daily. The children will continue to read words and sentences containing phase 3 graphemes.

The first text we will be exploring this half term is Superworm. During this topic, the children will be innovating and describing a new minibeast. The children will then look at the non-fiction text Yucky worms and will be writing a non-chronological minibeast report.

The children will be working on using finger spaces and capital letters in their writing.

The children will continue to have their weekly guided reading sessions.

### Mathematics:

We will be following the Lancashire Red Rose Maths Mastery scheme.

This term, EYFS will be: Counting, comparing and ordering, numbers to 20, measures, money, shape, sorting, patterning.
