### Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.45 and finishes at 3.10. The children are expected to come into school and organise their belongings and book bags independently. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. A member of staff will be available on the door for you to speak to. Unfortunately, parents **cannot come** into the building.

### Daily Snacks

Your child will be given a piece of fruit during snack time. If you want your child to have milk, you have to sign up to Cool Milk. <https://www.coolmilk.com/parents/>

Children can also purchase toast. This costs 20p per day. We would appreciate if you paid £1.00 for the week on a Monday. Toast will be available from week beginning 11<sup>th</sup> September.

### Reading Books

Children in Reception will have a home reading book when appropriate. It is expected that your child will share their reading book with you for 10-15 minutes a day. Reading books will only be changed if the reading diary has been signed. We request that your child has their reading book in school every day.

Initially this will be a phonics activity and then a reading book when your child can blend three letter words.

### Forest School

Your child will have access to Forest School Sessions. They will run every other Tuesday. Forest School kits will be kept in school (incl. wellies). After our welcome visit, our first session will be Tuesday 19th September. Refer to our class noticeboard/newsletter for more information.

### Personal Belongings

Please make sure all your child's belongings are clearly labelled. This includes their Forest School kit and PE kit.

### PE Day - Wednesday

Please can your child come dressed in their PE kit for the day. They will need to wear trainers.
