Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.40 and finishes at 3.10. Please arrive and collect your child at the double doors under the shelter. The children are expected to come into school and organise their belongings and book bags independently. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. Daily Snacks

Your child will be given a piece of fruit during snack time. Please ensure that any food brought to school are free from citrus, sesame seeds and nuts. Reading Books
