

Classroom Behaviour

Throughout St Paul's we encourage children to behave in a positive manner. We use 'Ready to Learn' and then move up or down the ladder according to their behaviour. Repeated or persistent misbehaviour, the following will apply: First time - a look/ a gesture/ a word/ point to the display. Second time - Verbal acknowledgement of unacceptable behaviour using the following; name and question, reminder of rule/ repeat the instructions/ clear description of desired behaviour. Third time - Verbal acknowledgement of unacceptable behaviour stating; an explanation of why the observed behaviour is unacceptable, immediately as the third warning is given the child's name is moved onto 'Think About It'. Fourth Time - If unacceptable behaviour continues then the child's name is moved onto 'Teacher's Choice' and the member of staff can choose an appropriate sanction. Fifth Time - If unacceptable behaviour continues then the child's name is moved onto 'Parental Contact' and parents are informed about their child's behaviour either by phone call/ home time or through an arranged meeting.

Good Behaviour

If children are consistently behaving well and making the correct choices then they can be moved up to 'Good Day' and then rewarded by being given other class rewards. If they do something outstanding then they move to 'Great Job' and then to 'Classroom Superstar'.

The Curriculum

As a year two your child will continue to access the National Curriculum and this will be taught through individual subjects. As in Year two, the class will follow a theme and the subjects covered will reflect this. English, Mathematics and Phonics are taught on a daily basis each morning.

Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.40am. The children are expected to come into school and organise their belongings and book bags independently. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. A member of staff will be available on the door for you to speak to.

Daily Snacks

We will not be serving toast at morning break, however you are welcome to bring a healthy snack that does not contain and nuts, sesame or citrus. Milk is available, please sign up via 'cool milk' online. Children should bring their own water bottles into school which are clearly labelled (bottles can be purchased from the office).

Reading Books

It is expected that your child will share their reading book with you for 10-15 minutes a day. Reading books will only be changed if the reading diary has been signed. Reading books will go out on a **Monday** and brought back into school on **Thursday**. Your child will pick their own reading books once they have finished.

Personal Belongings

Children don't need to bring any personal items from home e.g. bags, reading bags. School will provide a reading book folder and stationary. Children will only need a coat.

Homework

Homework will be given out every **Friday** online through Spelling shed and TT Rockstars. They will be given usernames and passwords.

Forest school

Your child will continue to have access to Forest School Sessions. These will be led by Mrs Smith. **They will run every other Thursday** and the whole class attends each session. Refer to our class noticeboard/newsletter for more information.

Children will need:

For Winter - **Long sleeved top, Long pants, wellies, hats, gloves and waterproofs**

For Summer - **Long sleeved top, Long pants, wellies, hats, sunglasses and trainers**

P.E

Outdoor P.E will be on **Wednesday afternoon**

Outdoor P.E kit - **Blue/black tracksuit with trainers and white t-shirt.**

Food

Due to children within school with allergies please be aware we are a nut/sesame seeds and citrus free school. So water bottles shouldn't contain any juice. If your child is bringing in a packed lunch please be mindful of these allergies.
