

### English (Literacy)

Let's go on a hunt. A bear hunt! Our main text this term is based around the book we are going on a bear hunt. We are going to look at the text, what makes a good story, plan our own adventure story and practice writing independently.

We are also going to look at descriptive writing based around the text Professor Astro Cat's Solar System.

This term is full of busy Maths and lots of interesting practical topics. We will cover:

*Sequencing and sorting* - number patterns and sorting numbers to a given criteria (counting in twos and fives)

*Fractions* - naming and recognising halves and quarters of shapes and objects.

Capacity and volume - practically measuring liquid volume and capacity.

*Money* - recognising coins 1p - 50p

Time - days of the week, months of the year and comparing events.

### Creative Curriculum

During History we are going to explore man's journey to space with a focus on Yuri Gagarin. How do we travel around the earth and to space? We are also going to explore the journeys we have been on.

The children will be looking at designing and making their own Christmas card with moving parts.

The children will also continue to go to forest school. We are going to look at Forest School maintenance but also making natural Christmas presents.

Computing -the children will be focusing on pictograms.

PE Children will practice the fundamentals of sport; throwing, kicking, running, jumping, hopping and catching. We will also have the sports coach in on Tuesday afternoons.

RE Children will be looking at Incarnation. What is incarnation what journey did Jesus go on to be incarnated. We will also be looking at the Christmas story and the journey to Jesus' birth.
