<u>Science</u> -- We will be focusing on Animals this half term-

EYFS- Explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.

Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary.

Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice.

Art- We will be creating 3D sculptures of London Landmarks in art this half term.

EYFS-Join different materials and explore different textures. Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.

<u>Geography-</u> We will be asking geographical questions to working on find out what London is like today. We will use maps, photographs and eyewitness accounts to answer these questions and compare London to Rawtenstall.

EYFS- Draw information from a simple map.

<u>History-</u> We will learn about The Great Fire of London and about the life of Samuel Pepys.

EYFS- Comment on images of familiar situations in the past. Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past.

## **English**

This half term we will be reading Non Chronological reports. We will be writing a report about London.

We will also be focussing on a story from a different culture with Handa's Surprise. Phonics and Guided Reading will continue to be taught each week.

PE We will follow the Lancashire Scheme of work. Our indoor and outdoor sessions will continue to focus on the fundamental skills. EYFS- Revise and refine the fundamental movement skills they have already acquired: • rolling • crawling • walking • jumping • running • hopping • skipping • climbing

<u>RE</u> Through our Christianity unit, we will learn about what Christian's believe God is like, focussing on the story of The Lost Sheep. <u>EYFS-Recognise</u> that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

**PSHCE** We will focus on Keeping Safe.

## Maths

EYFS-Children will work through the mastery programme, learning to recognise and identify numbers 1-10 (selecting, partitioning, counting, representing ordering and writing)

Y1-We will continue to learn through the Mastery approach. Our learning will build upon Autumn term- ordering and comparing numbers using place value. Multiplication and Division will begin to be taught, with children becoming more fluent with doubles and halves of numbers up to 10. In our Geometry unit, we will learn about shape, recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes. We will learn about measuring mass.
