

**English (Literacy):** This half term the children will be looking at stories with repeating patterns with a focus on We're going on a bear hunt. We will be adding the joining word and to our sentences.

We will also be exploring non-fiction texts as non-chronological reports. We will be using our knowledge of the Great Fire of London to write our own report.

The children will continue to have their daily phonics sessions and guided reading sessions.

**Mathematics:** We will be following the Lancashire Red Rose Maths Mastery scheme.

Year 1: measurement—mass and length, addition and subtraction, fractions, geometry—position and direction, time.

EYFS: addition and subtraction, halving and doubling, number sense.

**Art:** In art we are exploring 3D sculptures of buildings linked to our London topic using recycled art.

**DT:** This term we will be using different mechanisms to create our own product.

## Spring 2 - London is Burning



**Science:** In science the children are going to explore humans as animals.

We will be looking at the features of mammals and also our own body parts.

**PSHE:** We will be following the Scarf scheme of learning.

This half term's unit focus is on how children can keep themselves and their belongings safe.

**History:** For the next term we are exploring the cause of the Great Fire of London. We will dive deep into what caused the fire and how the significant figure Samuel Pepys documented the fire.

**Geography:** Linked to our Great Fire of London topic we are exploring human features of London.

**RE:** Children will be looking at a faith other than their own. We will be looking into Judaism.

**Forest School:** The children will attend Forest school on Wednesdays.

**PE:** PE will return to Mondays. This half term we are exploring dance by retelling the Great Fire of London story through musical movements.
