<u>Science</u> -- We will be focusing on Humans this half term. This will include learning more about our senses and basic parts of the human body. EYFS- Explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.

Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary.

Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice.

Art- We will be creating collages based on characters in stories by Eric Carle

EYFS-Join different materials and explore different textures. Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.

Geography- We will be finding out answers to the question: 'What is London like today?'. We will be locating the four countries of the UK and finding out about the capital cities of the countries.

EYFS- Draw information from a simple map.

<u>RE</u> Through our Judaism unit, we will learn about the story of Noah and learn more about trust. We will also learn about the Jewish festival of Sukkot. EYFS- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

English

This half term we will be reading and writing poetry based on London with AA Milne's 'Changing the guard at Buckingham Palace' poem. Our repetitive and structured story will be 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen, where we will create our own versions of the story.

Phonics and Guided reading will continue.

Spring 1- London's Burning



<u>PE</u> We will follow the Lancashire Scheme of work. Our outdoor sessions will continue to focus on the fundamental skill and our focus indoors will be on dance. <u>EYFS-Revise</u> and refine the fundamental movement skills they have already acquired: rolling · crawling · walking · jumping · running · hopping · skipping · climbing

<u>PSHCE</u> We will focus on our rights and our responsibilities.

Music- Combining pulse, rhythm and pitch

Maths

EYFS-Children will work through the mastery programme, using and applying numbers 1-10.

Y1-We will continue to learn through the Mastery approach. Our learning will build on measures (measuring length with a metre ruler and capacity with 1 litre). Addition and subtraction -adding and subtracting 1 and 2 digit numbers. Fractions- finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of small numbers and objects. Geometry-describing position including $\frac{1}{2}$ and whole turns and time- telling the time to o'clock and half past.

Computing

This half term, we will be using the computing room to learn more about ICT.
