

English (Literacy): This half term the children will be looking at stories by the same author, Oliver Jeffers, with a focus on Lost and Found. We will be writing sentences using capital letters and full stops.

We will also be exploring some non-fiction texts reading and writing a recount of a familiar event.

The children will continue to have their daily phonics sessions and guided reading sessions.

Mathematics: We will be following the Lancashire Red Rose Maths Mastery scheme.

Year 1: Sequencing and sorting, fractions, capacity and volume, money, time.

EYFS: Numbers 6-10

Art: In art we are exploring our drawing, painting and photography skills with a focus on our school building.

DT: We will be exploring different structures and how to create our own.

PSHE: We will be following the Scarf scheme of learning.

This half terms unit focus is on children's relationship with themselves and others.

Science: In science the children are going to explore and testing different materials.

We will be planning and performing different experiments on a variety of natural and manmade materials to find the most suitable for the end product.

History: For the next term we are exploring our school looking at the similarities and differences.

Geography: Linked to our school history topic we are going to explore maps and fieldwork of Rawtenstall and the Earth.

RE: Children will be looking at the Incarnation within Christianity. We will look at the story of Christmas and why it is important to Christians.

Forest School: The children will attend Forest school on Wednesdays.

PE: This half term we are focusing on invasion and target skills within a game scenario.
