

English (Literacy)

This half term the children will be looking at different stories. They will be reading the story 'Paddington' and this will be used as our story as a theme unit. They will also look at 'Goldilocks and the 3 Bears'.

The children will continue to have their daily phonics sessions and guided reading sessions.

Mathematics

This half term the children will be able to focus on number and place value. We will also be focusing on addition and subtractions, 2D and 3D shapes and length, mass/weight. The children will be able to use a variety of maths resources to help them understand concepts.

Creative Curriculum

In our topic lessons the children will be learning about capital cities of the UK and looking at basic map skills.

The children will also learn about old and new toys, old and new vehicles.

The children will be looking at designing and making their own sandwich for their teddy.

The children will also continue to go to forest school.

Computing -the children will be focusing programming using BeeBots

PE Children will practice travelling in a variety of ways; quick, slow, sideways and at a variety of speeds. They will practice key skills such as jumping, hopping, skipping etc.

RE Children will be looking at the unit God. They will explore stories from the bible and try to relate them to their own lives. .

Science

In science the children will look at the unit: materials and their properties. They will look at different types of materials, both natural and man-made.

The children will look at the properties of materials and their uses and then carry out simple experiments for finding the best material (once given a criteria)

The children will make simple predictions, carry out experiments and then record their results.
