Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.40am please follow our one way system and the children will be collected at 3.00. Parents and carers are not able to enter the building. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. Please send your child into school with only essential equipment. (lunchboxes, hats, coats and wellies). Bags will not be allowed into school.

Daily Snacks

Children are able to bring in a healthy snack as we will not be serving toast. Please ensure that all snacks brought to school are free from citrus, sesame seeds and nuts. Milk will be available for snack. You will need to sign up with 'Cool Milk' for this. Children may bring their water bottles to school which are clearly labelled.

Reading Books

it is expected that your child will share their reading book with you for at least 5 minutes every day. Books will be sent home every Monday and Friday. They will be quarantined for 72 hours before being returned to the reading boxes. Additional handwashing will be required from staff and pupils when selecting books.

P.E.

P.E sessions will take place on Thursday afternoons. To minimise bags and extra clothing being brought into school we ask that your child wears suitable clothes for this session. Please ensure your child is wearing a blue or black tracksuit and trainers on P.E. days.

Personal Belongings

Your child will have many different belongings which they will need to look after. Please make it easier for them by naming all items of clothing, including coats, hats and scarves. Wellies and waterproof pants and coat (for outdoor learning and Forest School) should be clearly labelled.

Classroom Behavior

Throughout St Paul's we encourage children to behave in a positive manner. We use a 'Learning Ladder' in all classrooms which are there to help all the children to manage their behavior. Any child who consistently does not follow our Golden Rules may miss some of their playtime/lunchtime to talk about their actions. Positive behavior will be rewarded.
