

English (Literacy)

This half term we will be looking at stories by the same author. We will focus on the work of Anthony Browne starting with his book The Tunnel/

This half term we will be focusing on getting ready to move into Year 1 or 2 and setting up strategies to help prepare ourselves when writing.

Mathematics

Science
