

English (Literacy)

We will be looking at the features of stories. The children will be reading the story 'Paddington' and this will be used as our story as a theme unit. They will also look at some poems based around our theme.

The children will continue to have their daily phonics sessions and guided reading sessions.

Mathematics

This half term the children will be focussing on number and place value. We will also be focusing on addition and subtractions, 2D and 3D shapes and length, mass/weight. The children will be able to use a variety of maths resources to help them understand concepts.

Creative Curriculum

In our topic lessons, the children will be learning about capital cities of the UK and looking at basic map skills.

They will be designing and making a carriage to go on the class train.

The children will also learn about old and new toys, old and new vehicles.

The children will also continue to go to forest school.

Cooking will also be linked to topics covered in class.

Computing -the children will be focusing on key skills using a computer

PE Children will practice travelling in a variety of ways; quick, slow, sideways and at a variety of speeds. They will practice climbing and jumping.

RE Children will discuss the groups they belong to. They will visit St Paul's church and learn about Baptism expression of belonging for Christians.

Science

In science, the children will look at the unit: materials and their properties. They will look at different types of materials, both natural and man-made.

The children will look at their properties and uses and then carry out simple experiments for finding the best material.

The children will make simple predictions, carry out experiments and then record their results.
