Art

The children will:

- Study Greek pottery designs
- Design a Greek pot using traditional patterns.
- Develop techniques to create a clay pot using slabs and coils.

Science-

The children will:

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
- Describe how teeth and gums have to be cared for in order to keep them healthy.
