

## English



## Science: Environment - Living things & their habitats.

- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- Explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.
- Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.
- Living things can be grouped (classified) in different ways according to their features. Classification keys can be used to identify and name living things.
- Living things live in a habitat which provides an environment to which they are suited.

These environments may change naturally e.g. through flooding, fire, earthquakes etc. Humans also cause the environment to change. This can be in a good way (i.e. positive human impact, such as setting up nature reserves) or in a bad way (i.e. negative human impact, such as littering). These environments also change with the seasons; different living things can be found in a habitat at different times of the year.

## ICT

Coding. The children will begin to use coding to make objects move on the screen or to change backgrounds. They will de-bug codes.  
Spreadsheets- The children will look at how to use cells and how to use functions.

## RE

The children will be learning about Christianity focusing on Salvation.

## PSHE

This half term we will be focussing on 'Rights and responsibilities'.

## Music

This half term the children will continue learning how to play the Ukelele. They will be taught by a specialist teacher Mr Williams.

Design, make and evaluate a money pouch (product) for an Anglo Saxon to carry money.

## Humanities

### History:

We will focus our History subject on the Anglo Saxons and how they have shaped Britain to how it is today. We will be looking at when and why they invaded, who and where they settled and also what impact they have had on life in Britain today in terms of houses, clothing, food, machines/farming, language and place names. The children will also look at sources of evidence and what these tell us about Anglo Saxon times.

### Geography:

We will focus on locational knowledge, land use and patterns this half term. We will be recapping the continents and Oceans; United Kingdom and its countries. We will be looking at the different uses of land in England and in the areas the Anglo Saxons came from.
