Year 4- 3D shape place value, multiplication, division, addition and subtraction.

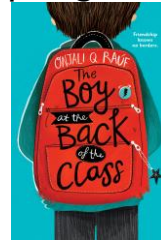
Year 5- Multiplication and division, Fractions, Area, Time, place value, addition and subtraction, measures and geometry.

Outdoor learning

Outdoor Learning will take place fortnightly on a Wednesday.

Science- Sound

The children will:

Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating.

Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.

Find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it.

Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.

Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.

Working scientifically, they will:

Make ear defenders from a variety of different materials to investigate /test which provides the best insulation against sound.
