The Curriculum

As a year three your child will continue to access the National Curriculum and this will be taught through individual subjects. As in Year three, the class will follow a theme and the subjects covered will reflect this. English and Mathematics are taught on a daily basis each morning.

Entry to School

The school day begins at **8.40am**. The children are expected to come into school and organise their belongings and book bags independently. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. A member of staff will be available on the door for you to speak to.

Daily Snacks
