Research Morse Code and how it was used during World War Two.

Design and test out a parachute (using a toy or a weight) that would allow a member of the RAF to land safely.



Create a piece of art which shows a World War Two scene.

This could be a drawing, painting or collage of a World War Two.

Visit the Tate or the National Portrait Gallery website for inspiration of WW2 artists and their work.

Choose a famous pop artist from 1930s onwards. Use the internet to research their life and present your facts in an interesting way.



Recreate a model of something that is significant to World War Two. For example: a tank, a spitfire plane, a gas mask.

This can be made from a media of your own choosing.



Write a story that is set during World War Two. Use your knowledge of evacuation or the events of the war to help with the detail in your writing.



Bake or cook a wartime recipe.
Remember to be careful when weighing and
measuring ingredients.

Take photos and bring in the recipe you used.
