







Mighty Oaks - Creative Curriculum homework Autumn 2

<p>In class, we have been looking at art across the decades. Using the techniques and materials used, create your own art work that represents Pop Art, Op Art or Grafitti Art.</p> 	<p><i>These optional activities link to the class learning for Autumn 2. Choose one of the following activities to complete at home or think of your own project related to our class topic. Please bring into school before the end of the half term.</i></p>	<p>Research Morse Code and how it was used during World War Two. Create your own code for a friend to crack.</p> 
<p>Design and make a simple board game for 2 players based on fractions. The focus should be based on one of the following fraction topics: equivalent fractions; comparing and ordering; adding and subtracting; multiplying and dividing.</p>	<p>Choose one theme from the following: Love, friendship, trust, bravery. Compose a song, setting out using a poetic structure. It could be free verse or rhyming.</p> 	<p>Choose a famous pop artist from 1930s onwards. Use the internet to research their life and present your facts in an interesting way.</p> 
<p>Recreate a model of something that is significant to World War Two. For example: a tank, a spitfire plane, a gas mask. This can be made from a media of your own choosing.</p> 	<p>Write a story that is set during World War Two. Use your knowledge of evacuation or the events of the war to help with the detail in your writing.</p> 	<p>Bake or cook a wartime recipe. Remember to be careful when weighing and measuring ingredients. Take photos and bring in the recipe you used.</p>
