English (Literacy)

The following stories will be used to link with our theme 'Here and There' including 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears 'A Chair for Baby Bear' and 'Paddington goes to London'

We will also orally recall and begin to write recounts about journeys children have made.

Children will be encouraged to write/mark make invitations, tickets, lists and passports, posters, signs and rules as they work in continuous provision.

Phonics will be taught daily. Guided Reading will take place weekly.

Children will be encouraged to use a range of materials to design and make their homes.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Children will begin to learn about houses and household objects in the past, comparing these to objects we use now.

Understanding of the World

<u>Computing</u> Find their homes using Google Earth. Use BeeBots to control around a map. Use simple programmes to order numbers.

<u>**PE**</u> Children will practice travelling in a variety of ways; quick, slow, sideways and at a variety of speeds. They will practice climbing and jumping. Children will also practice throwing into targets.

Children will continue to count objects to 10 and beyond, selecting the correct numerals and Numicon resources to represent the numbers. They will begin to find 1 more/1 less than a given number.
