Follow the English lessons uploaded to the class page or found on the learning for all section. If you took a break last week you can choose week 6 about Forests or look out for week 7 lesson plan.


Maths

Solve the Maths problems -

At the puppy training session there are 30 legs. One puppy has one owner at the training session. How many puppies are at the training session? How many different answers can you find?



Think of a number, how many different ways can you make it. Start with a 2 digit number and then for a harder challenge, try a 3 digit number.



Play the missing number game uploaded onto class page this week.

Art/DT Imagine you find a secret door - draw what you see through the door.



Design a new chocolate bar - make a list of the ingredients and design the packet to make other people want to buy it.

Science - Dangers of the Sun - we will be covering this topic on the next grid as well.

Read through the slides on the PowerPoint uploaded onto the class page.

Carry out the experiment to show UV light -

Cut out several shapes from any coloured card.

Place them on a piece of black paper/card, and position them in a sunny spot for a week (any dark or bright coloured card can be used).

When you take the shapes off, you should see that the paper around the shapes has changed colour slightly.

The paper under the shapes will still look the same.

The UV light could not get to the paper under the shapes, so the paper under the shapes has not been damaged by the UV rays.
