

Home-Learning Ideas – KS1 Theme: Pirates

When a learning activity has been completed, the box can be coloured in. When the all the boxes have been coloured – try the challenge boxes

English

Fold a piece of paper into 4 and choose 4 characters to draw and label.

What number do they live at? What else do you know about them? Can you use words from the text to help you?

English

Create a grid to show the link between what the characters complained about and what the pirates left for them in their garden.

Character	Their complaint	Their present from the pirates
Mrs Divine	She moaned about their dirtiness, their old clothes and their scruffy hats.	Golden pirate hat.

English Challenge

Write a postcard from Tilda to Jim. What could she tell him about life in Dull-on-Sea since the pirates left?

Can you write a postcard to someone you haven't seen for a while and post it to them?

English Challenge

Look through the book again. How many skull and crossbones can you find hidden in the pictures? Do you think Tilda's mum is a secret pirate?


