

### English

Our text will continue to focus on Wonder by R J Palacio. We will be looking at writing a biography, discussion text, poetry and retells and narrative using dialogue.  
Guided reading will focus on reading techniques and making inferences about a text.  
Spelling and grammar will be taught through key skills sessions.

### Maths

Maths lessons will focus on revision of key facts from all of key stage two in preparation for the end of key stage two assessments in May.  
Mental arithmetic, written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as reasoning problems will be reinforced through daily lessons.

### PE

Indoor PE will focus on athletics. We will be looking at developing skills and how these are applied in a range of athletic tasks.

### Science Light (continued)

- \*Recognise that light travels in a straight line.
- \*Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light in the eye.
- \*Explain that we see things because the light that travels from light sources to our eyes or from sources to objects.
- \*Explain why shadows have the same shape as objects that cast them.
- \* How the eye works and Braille.
