English

This half term the children will be using the book as a stimulus for writing and will be writing a historical narrative, a persuasive letter, and a recount in the form of a diary. We will be looking at grammar each day and focussing on many aspects of grammar including complex sentences, conjunctions and the use of various punctuation.

We will be using a number of other short stories and information texts. We will also use clips from the literacy shed to help with visualisation.

<u>Art</u>

- 3D shape

Geography-

This half term we will be looking at the importance of taking care of the environment. They will consider environments at a range of scales from their classroom to the whole world. It will include issues around litter and waste e.g. damage to the environment; reducing the level of resource use; and reuse, as well as recycling, of resources. Children will recognise how people can adversely affect, as well as improve, the environment.

History-

In History, we will be looking at The Great Plague. The children will be looking at how the great plague began, how it spread and what happened throughout the pandemic. We will relate this and compare it to the pandemic in the present day.
