Parent Pay update

Please could all parents activate your account to pay for school dinners, Bright Young Things, after-school clubs and any trips that will occur throughout the year.

A Reminder text has been sent out today, if you need another copy of your activation letter please come to the school office.

The system is now ready to pay for Bright Young Things. Sessions are added half termly however ParentPay will bill you on a daily basis. If for example you look at your balance today - that balance will be the total owing from the 5th September to today. Below are the session and charge breakdown so you can work out your weekly bill and multiply by weeks in the half term. Remember to deduct 50 pence per session for a second sibling. As you are aware, the fees should be paid in advance.

<u>Before School</u> 7:30am-8:45am £2.50 8:00am-8:45am £1.50

After School 3:10pm-4:30pm £2.50 3:10pm-5:30pm £4.50 3:10pm-6:00pm £5.50

A text message will be sent out to all parents informing you when the system is running correctly for lunch payments.

After half term, school will no longer accept cash or cheques payments.

We anticipate some teething problems over the first few weeks and we would be very grateful for your patience as the system is embedded into our routines. If you have any queries please let the school office know.
