English

This half term we will be using Holes by Louis Sachar, as part of our novel as a theme work. We will also be looking at writing descriptively, non-chronological reports and explanation texts, including their language and organisational features.

Spelling homework will be supported by The Spelling Shed and ten spellings a week will be given for the children to learn.

Children are also expected to read for at least 15 minutes each day and this reading is to be recorded in their diaries.

Additional reading comprehension maybe sent home to support work within school.

Maths

Key skills will focus on negative numbers, geometry (angles within shapes), calculating, fractions and statistics.

It is expected that all children are fluent in using their times tables - up to 12x12. These will be practised daily and can be supported at home using TT Rockstars. Fluency skills will also develop accuracy in fractions, using all four operations and powers of 10.

PSHCE

Keeping safe is the focus this half term. The children will look at ways to keep themselves safe in different situations and how to manage risk, especially when online and with peers.
