English

Our text focus this half term will be based on Wonder by R J Palacio. We will be looking at writing a biography, discussion text, poetry and narrative using dialogue.

Guided reading will focus on reading techniques and making inferences about a text.

Drama will also feature as we begin rehearsals for our end of vear production.

Maths

Key skills will focus on working collaboratively to solve problems and to complete maths projects, ready for the transition to high school. We will also be consolidating times tables facts, methods of multiplication and division, percentages, ratio and proportion and fractions of numbers. We will apply these when working mentally.

Key skills will also focus on using a range of operations to reason and explain.

PSHCE

The Unit this term is SRE - Growing and Changing unit. This will focus on dealing with changes emotionally and physically; body image; media influence; transition to new places - high school and ways to navigate.

We will also be following the Raising Aspirations programme - an initiative designed to support Year 6 in their future careers.
