#### Creative Writing Homework - The Twits

- Choose a bird to research. The bird may be from the text ("buzzard, magpie, rook, raven") but also any others with interesting features or unusual habitats (such as, from the UK: barn owl, cockerel, cuckoo, robin, black-headed gull, swan, vulture, green woodpecker; and from outside the UK: albatross, hummingbird, ostrich, parrot, peacock, pelican, penguin, puffin, vulture.)

Research key facts about the bird, using these guidelines:

- The bird's habitat - where it lives;
- The bird's plumage - the colours and patterns of its feathers;
- What the bird likes to eat;
- Any distinguishing features (for example: a long neck, a strong beak, a nice song);
- The bird's behaviour (for example, owls are wise; puffins are very sociable and hang around in enormous groups; albatrosses spend much of their life flying.)

- Design, make and decorate Muggle-Wump's Dream Tree-House, with lots of imaginative additions, and reasons why he would like them.
- Write a new chapter of the story in which Muggle-Wump, the monkeys and the Roly Poly Bird all try to execute your idea for a trick. How do the Twits react? Does the plan work? Do Mr and Mrs Twit think of a sneaky way out of your plan, or do they fall for it perfectly?
- Invent Mrs Twit's Trick Menu.

This should have: - A Starter, Main Course and Dessert;

- A name and description for each entry;
- A disclaimer at the bottom, warning the diner what might happen if they try any of the items on Mrs Twit's Menu. ('Warning! May cause...')

E.g Starter: Tomato-blood soup. Main: Pus Pizza with Tarantula. Topping Dessert: Vomit ice cream

There are some optional homework sheets as well. Only do these if you have time and if they want to do them.
