



St. Paul's PTA 100 Club

St. Paul's PTA currently runs a 100 club. The 100 Club is open to all parents, carers and teaching staff of children at St. Paul's and it is very simple to join.

What is a 100 Club? A 100 Club is a form of private lottery where members buy numbered tickets which are entered into a monthly draw. Every month one number is drawn and the winner gets half the value of the fund (with the exception of December when the winner receives 75% of the prize fund*), the balance goes into the PTA funds.

The draw will take place at the end of each month. The winning number will be on our PTA Facebook page and the lucky winner will be notified by the PTA direct.

How much does it Cost? The cost of this is £2 per month or if you prefer you can pay a lump sum in advance for the year. You can either pay this by monthly or yearly standing order/bank transfer. The more members we have the greater the monthly prize!

How do we Join? We ask that you fill in and return the attached form in an envelope marked 'PTA 100 Club'. Once we have received this we will contact you to arrange payment and confirm that your number will be included in the next draw. Please remember to sign the form to confirm you have read the 'small print'. You can also enter by sending us an email with the details needed overleaf. There is no limit to the amount of "numbers" you can hold - as long as for each "number" you pay £2.00 per month.

'The Small Print'

The monthly winner will be notified and a cheque will be issued payable to the name at the top of this form. Payment must be received by the PTA between the 1st and 15th of the month otherwise your chosen number will be removed from the month end draw. Members can join the 100 club at any time of the year, however, *to be eligible for the 75% share at Christmas members must have been in the 100 club since the start of the academic year (September). Otherwise the 50% share will apply. If you wish to come out of the club just let us know and we will take your number out of the draw, however, if you have paid in advance for the year we will continue to enter your number as no refunds will be given. Preferred numbers will be issued on a first come, first served basis and will only be secured on receipt of payment. The deadline for any bank payments is 15th of each month. Any money received after this date will be done so by the discretion of the PTA committee. All members must be over the age of 16.
