Swimming at St Paul's - Willows' Class

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of the Physical Education Curriculum, Willows class will be going swimming from September to February.

Lessons will take place every Wednesday afternoon at St Peter's Centre, Burnley and as this is part of the National Curriculum there is no cost for this. Children will travel by coach and will return by the end of the school day.

The first lesson will take place on Wednesday 11th September 2019.

In line with our school policy, the following information regarding kit must be adhered to:

- Boys are expected to wear plain fitted swim trunks. No baggy shorts are allowed. In the case where your son has long hair, this should be secured in a plain swim cap.
- Girls should wear a plain one piece swimming costume and a plain swim cap to secure hair back.

It is your child's responsibility to remember their kit each week and as these lessons are part of the required education, the school will implement reminders to children who repeatedly forget their kit. Please note, St Peter's are no longer able to lend swimming caps.

Children do not need to bring any toiletries as there will not be time to shower before returning to school.
