The Curriculum

Your child will continue to or start accessing the National Curriculum and this will be taught through individual subjects. As in Acorns, the class will follow a theme and the subjects covered will reflect this. English, Mathematics and Phonics are taught on a daily basis each morning.

Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.45. The children are expected to come into school and organise their belongings and book bags independently. Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. A member of staff will be available on the door for you to speak to.

Daily Snacks

Children are able to purchase toast during morning playtime. The cost for this is 10p per day; however it is also possible to pay on a weekly basis if this is what you would prefer. Children may also bring in their own healthy snack to eat during morning break. Fruit will also be provided during milk and snack time. Parents need to sign up and pay for milk.

Reading Books

It is expected that your child will share their reading book with you for 10-15 minutes a day. Reading books will only be changed if the reading diary has been signed. New books will be changed and sent home on Wednesday alongside homework. We request that your child has their reading book in school every day.

Personal Belongings

Your child will have different belongings which they will need to look after. Please make it easier for them by naming all items of clothing, including coats, hats and scarves. Named P.E. kits should be placed on their pegs and are sent home at the end of each half term.

Homework and Reading books

Homework and reading books are given out every Wednesday and are to be handed in on the following Monday. Please encourage your child to place it in the homework box once it has been completed.

Forest school

Your child will continue to have access to Forest School Sessions. These will be led by Mrs Smith and myself. They will run every other Thursday and the whole class attends each session. Refer to our class noticeboard/newsletter for more information.
