Throughout St Paul's we encourage children to behave in a positive manner. We use a ready to learn behaviour ladder. All children start the day at 'ready to learn', they move up to celebrate work and behaviour. They move down the ladder when they demonstrate negative behaviour. We also give out dojos and house points. Children receive value stickers for demonstrating our school Christian values.

## Control and Protective Measures COVID 19

### Entry to School

The school day begins at 8.50am, please follow our one way system and children will be collected at 3.10pm. Please be aware parents/carers are not able to enter the building. . Please ensure that if your child has something to hand in, that they are aware of this. Please only send your child with essential equipment (lunchboxes, hats, coats, wellies). Bags will not be allowed into school.

### Daily Snacks

We will not be serving toast at morning break, however you are welcome to bring a healthy snack that does not contain and nuts, sesame or citrus. Milk is available, please sign up via 'cool milk' online. Children should bring their own water bottles into school which are clearly labelled (bottles can be purchased from the office).

## Reading Books

It is expected that your child will share their reading book with you for at least 5 minutes every day. Pupils will be allowed to take reading books home from school each Monday and Friday, they will be 'quarantined' for 72 hours before being returned to the reading book boxes. Additional hand washing for staff and pupils will be required when selecting reading books.

## Personal Belongings

Your child will have different belongings which they will need to look after. Please make it easier for them by naming all items of clothing, including coats, hats and scarves and PE kits.

## Homework and Reading books

Homework (via 'Spelling Shed' and 'My Maths' will be given out every Friday and are to be handed in on the following Wednesday. More information will be given regarding this!
