Science - Materials

The children will learn to:

Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials.
Explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials, and that this kind of change is not usually reversible.
Demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes.
Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.
Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a
