English

We will be designing gadgets and explaining how they work. We will be looking at aspects of grammar linked to explanation text writing. We will be learning to spell homophones and near homophones.

Maths

Our Maths Learning will continue to follow the Lancashire Scheme of Work for Mathematics. We will be covering: Fractions Volume Perimeter 2d and 3d shapes Statistics

In Science we will be learning how to:

Associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit.

Compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches.

Use recognised symbols (at least: cells, wires, switches, bulbs, buzzers and motors) when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.

Use/interpret circuit diagrams to construct a variety of more complex circuits predicting whether they will 'work'.
