English

This half term we will begin with a unit on Classical Narrative Poetry looking at the poem 'Timothy Winters' by Charles Causley. We will then be completing our work around the novel 'Streetchild' by Berlie Doherty. The children will write historical story settings. They will write diaries, letters and character descriptions linked to the book. There will be a strong focus on developing our vocabulary. We will perform scripted scenes making use of dramatic conventions. We will write a diary entry about life in The Workhouse and a non – chronological report about Britain in the Victorian Times.

We will be comparing 'Streetchild' with the film Oliver Twist.
