

English

This half term we will be developing our knowledge of poems through 'poems about me' and personalising the poem 'The Magic Box' by Kit Wright.

We will be reading Funny Bones (and linking this to our work in Science). We will also learn to write in a persuasive style, linking our work in History.

Most children will be writing simple sentences by carefully sounding out words containing Phase 5 phonics.

Guided reading will also take place each week.

We will be learning about our home areas and making simple maps.

History

We will learn about the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and how they inspired modern nursing.

Art

We will be creating our own self-portraits and learning about the artist Picasso.

We will follow the Lancashire Scheme of work, developing our learning of keeping ourselves fit and healthy (linked with Science). We will also develop our games skills with our coach each Tuesday.

Maths

The children will become more confident to recognise the place value of numbers. We will also develop our addition and subtraction skills, work on shape, fractions and capacity.

Science

We will learn about our amazing bodies-drawing and labelling basic parts of our human body and linking parts of our body to our senses.
